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INTERNAL CORRELATIONS of REEP Instructional Levels to REEP Skill Levels

While the REEP Curriculum has 10 instructional levels (100, 150, 200, 250, 300, 350, 400, 450, 500, and 550), there are only 6 levels for each individual skill areas (reading, writing, speaking, listening). The individual skill levels overlap within the instructional levels. This overlap of skill levels within the instructional levels allows students to move through the curriculum at their own pace without having to repeat the same material.

There are 6 levels for each individual skill area and they match up to the instructional levels in the following way:

SPEAKING AND LISTENING

REEP SKILL LEVELS	REEP INSTRUCTIONAL LEVELS	COMMENTS
1	100 and 150	Speaking and listening skills are similar for these two instructional levels.
2	200 and 250	Speaking and listening skills are similar for these two instructional levels.

4	300	This is not a typo. 300 speaking and listening skills are higher than 350. 300 is a level for good speakers/low readers and writers.
5	400 and 450	Speaking and listening skills are similar for these two instructional levels.
6	500 and 550
